## **Registration and Check-In**

**1** - Troops may check-in Friday, January 30th at the Dining Hall between 7:00pm *and* 9:00pm. No Troops should plan to arrive prior to 7:00pm, and those that plan to arrive after 9:00 p.m. should make special arrangements with the Klondike Administrator-Jeff Duncan 516-901-7763.

**2** - Saturday, January 31st, check-in will be from 7:00am to 9:00am at the Baiting Hollow Dining Hall.

**3** - *At check-in, please have the following ready and prepared:*

**A. 1 copies of the registration form.**

**B. An Electronic Copy of the Troop roster ( list all boys and adults in the camp ).**

**C. Notify the staff in writing of any special medical problems or considerations.**

**D. Any additional financial obligations and fees should be paid at this time to the Klondike Administrator – Jeff Duncan**

**4 - Scoutmasters only should check their troops in.** Upon completion of item #3 above, you will be given specific instructions and information regarding your troops campsite.

**5** - Upon receiving your campsite information, your Senior Patrol Leader should direct the troop to your campsite. The distance from the main parking lot to your campsite will **be less than one mile.** The Scouts should hike to their campsites. No cars will be Permitted into the camping area!

**6** - It is suggested that each patrol utilize their sleds to carry patrol equipment to the campsite. Troop equipment should be brought in this way also.

**7** - There will be Emergency Vehicles near the Dining Hall.

**8** - Troops that register first were given priority. Tent sites are ample and probably warmer!

**9** - *The First Aid Station is located in the Dining Hall.* Water is available near the Dining Hall. All campsites have a latrine nearby.

**10** - The actual campsite that you have been assigned may be changed at the last minute ... if there are circumstances beyond our control.

*Should you have any questions or concerns please do not hesitate to contact the Klondike Administrator. The Staff want both your boys and yourself to enjoy the weekend. This is your Camporee! Feel free to offer suggestions prior to the weekend.*
